CTLS GOALS

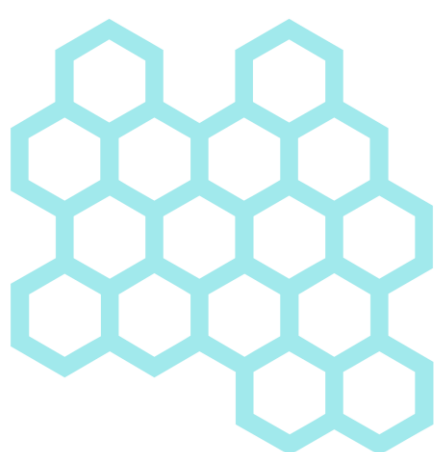
- CTLS supports the professional development of core facility staff at all stages of their working life
